1. Student parking permits will be issued to **SENIORS** and a limited number of **JUNIORS** with extensive involvement in school activities.
2. Student parking is in the two main lots in **front** of the school and along the fence on the side of the school adjacent to the cafeteria. Students are prohibited from parking in any area reserved for the staff, visitors, maintenance, handicapped, athletic fields, grass, areas along Chief Trail marked by the yellow curb, or in the bus lane.
3. Parking decals must be attached **INSIDE on the REAR WINDOW – LOWER RIGHT**.
4. Once parked, no student is permitted to remain in the vehicle, return to the parking lot during school hours, or leave school grounds during school hours without authorization from the administration.
5. There is a **non-transferable and non-refundable \$45.00** fee for each decal set forth by VBCPS. If you no longer own your vehicle, come to the main office to update the information. **Bring the old decal in order to receive a new decal, or you will be charged for a new one.** If you drive a different automobile on any day, you must obtain a "Temporary Permit" by **7:10 a.m.** You may be required to show related vehicle registration.
6. The parking fee for **ATC and Tech Center students** is **\$35.00 at Kempsville HS** and **\$10.00 at ATC/ Tech Center** (must purchase decal at ATC/Tech Center first).
7. The school is not responsible for any vehicle or its contents. Drivers are advised to leave vehicles locked and to refrain from leaving valuables anywhere in the vehicles. The school holds the right to search any vehicle on school grounds.
8. Safe driving habits are mandatory. There is to be no speeding or any form of reckless driving on school grounds. The speed limit is **FIVE MILES PER HOUR**. Violators will be reported to VBPD.
9. Students are expected to arrive at school at a reasonable time in order to ensure a parking space. Students who arrive late may not find a parking space available. Tardiness resulting from this situation will not be excused.
10. Parking is based on a first-come, first-served basis, and vehicles parked illegally will be immobilized at any time. **Parking fines of \$25.00 will be charged for a vehicle parked illegally or without a sticker.**
11. The "No Smoking" or possession of tobacco or vape products regulation also applies to the parking lot and in the vehicle. All school rules are in effect in the parking lots and access roads to KHS.
12. Any student leaving from school shall not return to school to pick up other students at the end of the day.
13. Parking privileges can be **suspended** by the school administration. The period of suspension can be a **minimum of one week to a maximum of one school year** for the following reasons (but not limited to these reasons): **poor academic performance, truancy, tardiness, suspensions, misconduct, or reckless driving.**

IMPORTANT: If a wrecker is called to tow a vehicle and the owner/driver of the vehicle appears before it is hooked up and towed, the wrecker will proceed with the towing unless the owner/driver of the vehicle can make satisfactory financial arrangements with the wrecker for his/her time and trouble.
