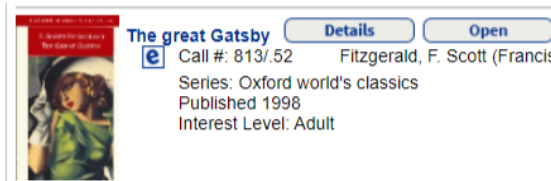




Stuck at home? Read a book!

So many FREE options, accessible from your device,
that don't require you to leave your house!

- **Destiny Discover** (VB Schools Library eBooks)
 - Visit link above or go to Classlink and click on Reference Databases and then Destiny.
 - Select your location/school if requested.
 - In the top right of Destiny, login with your student number and regular network password.
 - Under Material Type, select *Electronic Book (eBook)*.
 - Search the catalog for books with the “e” logo as seen in the example below, and click to open. You may check them out as well.



- **Overdrive by Libby** (app or website) and **RB Digital** (app or website) from the **Virginia Beach Public Library**
 - Ebook and audiobook options
 - Download the free apps on your phone or tablet (RB Digital and/or Libby for Overdrive) or access on your Chromebook or other computer
 - Use your student public library card to access (every VB student has one automatically!)
 - Your library = Virginia Beach Public Library
 - Enter library account details –
 - Card number = S + VBCPS student ID # (example: S1234567)
 - PIN = date of birth in MMDD format (example: July 4 birthday would be 0704)

- **Hoopla (app or website) from the Virginia Beach Public Library**
 - Movies, music, audiobooks, ebooks, comics, and TV shows
 - Download the free Hoopla app on your phone or tablet or access on your Chromebook or other computer
 - Use your Teen or Adult public library card to access (not your VB student library account) – call 757-385-0150 to get a temporary digital card.

- **Audible via Amazon**
 - Audiobooks only
 - No login required
 - Click on the link to the category at the top (Teen, Literary Classics, Folk and Fairy Tales for All, books in foreign languages, etc.).
 - Click on the title of your choice, and start listening!

- Note that a Teen Card may be obtained by anyone 13-17 without a parent or guardian's signature needed.
- Youth/Teen/Adult cards can still access digital resources regardless of blocked/expired status and there is currently no end date for those permissions. Residents can call the Central Library (757-385-0150) to set up a card, or call Central or their local branch library to get information about their cards' status.
- Residents can renew library cards over the phone as long as they aren't updating any information or have fines, which can be paid either online via the library website or in person at one of the open branches (Central, Kempsville, Bayside, Princess Anne, and Law Library).

 - **Holds on physical items can be picked up at the branch location of patron's choice, either inside the building if it's open, or in lobby/drive-through service if it is closed (Oceanfront, Great Neck, Pungo, and Joint-Use Library).
