Homework

Late homework will not be penalized more than 50%. The purpose of homework is to prepare for new instruction, to provide practice, and to allow for application of curricular content.

Late Work

Late work is to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%. Exemptions to this policy are at the teacher's informed professional discretion.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros on missing assignments are considered late work and are to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%. Teachers may excuse students from assignments at their discretion. Exemptions to this policy are at the teacher's informed professional discretion.

Reassessment

For students who receive a failing grade on a summative assessment: Two week time frame
• Students must have:
• participated in class
• completed assignments
• Demonstrated evidence of best effort on the assessment and the learning leading up to the assessment.
• All other assignments must be completed

Make-up Work

Make-up work, including tests, are to be completed within three school days after the student returns to school. Teachers will provide reasonable and flexible deadlines that take into consideration a student's individual circumstances. Students who receive unexcused absences may make up assignments at the discretion of the teacher.

Extra Credit

The use and weight for extra credit will be determined at the time of the assignment.

Homework

The purpose of homework is to prepare for new instruction, provide practice, & allow for application of curricular content.

Late Work

Late work is to be completed by the date of the summative assessment for each unit.

Late work will not be penalized more than 50%.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zero's on missing assignments are considered late work and are to be completed by the date of the summative assessment for each unit.

Reassessment

Must be completed within 2 weeks of the original assessment.

Students can be reassessed when they have participated in class, completed all class assignments in preparation for the assessment, demonstrated evidence to the best of best effort on the assessment and the learning leading up to the assessment, and made a formal request to the teacher.

Make-up Work

Make up work, including tests, are to be completed within three school days after the student returns to school. (Reasonable, flexible, deadlines that take into consideration a student's individual circumstance will be considered on a case by case basis.)

Extra Credit

Extra credit awarded in circumstances when student has gone above & beyond the required content material. The use & weight of extra credit will be determined at the time an assignment is assigned.
