Late Work

Reassessment

Make-up Work

Test and quiz make-up times must be scheduled with the teacher on the date of return. Make-up assignments will be marked **AB** in the gradebook and given a 0 until they are made up. **All make-up work, including tests and quizzes, must be made up within three school days after the student returns to school.**

Extra credit assignments will not be given. Students may however have the opportunity to earn extra credit points on assignments given throughout the quarter.
