Homework

- Reading/Assignments will be assigned each day to reinforce material presented in the classroom. Assignments will be checked at the beginning of the block. *Assigned work is essential for student understanding of daily lessons and therefore must be completed on time to ensure student success, AND guide teacher planning & feedback.*

Late Work

- Late work is to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Exemptions to this policy are at the teacher's informed professional discretion. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%. E

Explanation of Zeroes

- Zeros on missing assignments are considered late work and to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%. Teachers may excuse students from assignments at their discretion. Exemptions to this policy are at the teacher's informed professional discretion.

Reassessment

- For students who receive a failing grade on a summative assessment: • Two week time frame • Students must have: • participated in class • completed assignments • Demonstrated evidence of best effort on the assessment and the learning leading up to the assessment. • All other assignments must be completed.

Make-up Work

- Make-up work, including test, are to be completed within three school days after the student returns to school. Teachers will provide reasonable and flexible deadlines that take into consideration a student's individual circumstances. Students who receive unexcused absences may make up assignments at the discretion of the teacher.

Extra Credit

- The use and weight for extra credit will be determined at the time of the assignment.
