### Homework

Homework is not assigned, however, when a student needs to catch up due to an excused absence, he/she will be given the missed assignment and it will be marked as homework. There is no penalty for homework unless it is never turned in.

### Late Work

Students are expected to complete all assignments **on time**. If a student needs additional time on an assignment, please discuss this with Ms. Rose. Grading will begin at 80% for work turned in late. Gradient to 10% off for each day after. Students have one week to submit missed assignments.

### Explanation of Zeroes

Zero grades will be posted after all make-up work and homework time is exhausted. Work can be turned in upon the discretion of the teacher to extend to include posting a grade at the end of the quarter. Any work not turned in will receive a zero grade.

### Reassessment

Reassessments will be done for the following: students with accommodations requiring reassessment. All students, however, will be given the opportunity to pass an assessment.

### Make-up Work

It is the student's responsibility to make up all missed assignments after an absence. It is recommended that students check Google Classroom for missed assignments posted. The student has one week to turn in an assignment or complete an assessment for one day of absenteeism. Students will be given 100% credit for make-up work.
