



Grading Practices

School: Kempsville High School grade

Subject(s): Culinary Arts, Catering, Parenting and Child Development, Introduction to Child Care Occupations and Resource Management for Independent Living.

Grade Level: 9-12 grade

Homework

Homework: Students are expected to complete all assignments in class. Incomplete class work is considered homework and should be completed at home or in study block. If assignment is turned in at the beginning of the next block, full credit will be awarded otherwise the late policy will be applied. Makeup work is considered homework and should be done at home or during study block. Homework/make up work completed during instruction will not be accepted.

Late Work

Late Work: Makeup work is late if not turned in within one week of students return to school. In class assessments are late if not turned in by the end of the block. Assessments not turned in on time are considered late and will result in a zero in the grade book for the assignment. Zero will be replaced with a grading penalty of 10% off when work is turned in. Violating honor code by copying will result in a zero grade. Photographing others assignments and then copying will result in a zero grade. Students who allow their assignment to be copied or photographed will receive a zero grade.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros: It is the student's responsibility to see the teacher and check the absent tray for makeup work and turn it in for full credit within 1 week of returning to school. Failure to do so will result in a zero for the assignment. After one week the assignment is considered late and a grading penalty of 10% off for late will be applied. Students are expected to complete all assignments when present in class and turn them into the designated area before the end of class. Failure to do so will result in a zero for the assignment. Zero will be replaced with a 10% grading penalty when work is turned in.

Reassessment

Reassessment Redo/retake is for non-mastery of summative assignments. Students will be permitted to redo/retake summative assignments when he or she has failed to show 69% mastery. All redo/retakes

must be completed within 14 school days of the original due date. The deadline to complete a redo/retake is at least two days before report card grades are submitted.

Make-up Work

Makeup Lab Redo Makeup labs are completed at home. **Home Makeup Lab: First** missed lab; student needs to obtain a makeup lab sheet from the teacher. The makeup lab sheet signed by the parent/guardian along with a sample is turned back into the teacher. Makeup labs must be turned in within **two weeks** of the original lab. Procedure for the second missed lab is the same as the first along with a 3 page research paper.

Extra Credit

Extra Credit: Culinary classes may turn in extra credit product each quarter, worth 10 extra credit points. Find a recipe utilizing the concepts in the classroom; prepare it, video journal progress, turn in sample for evaluation. For 5 additional points bring a sample for the class.
