Homework

Because homework is intended to prepare students for the current day's lesson, students may not turn in late homework. Absences will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

Late Work

Late work will be penalized 15%. Some long-term assignments may not be completed late, unless the teacher determines that extenuating circumstances exist.

Explanation of Zeroes

If a student has exhausted all opportunities for turning in late work, the 0 will remain to be calculated as part of the nine weeks' grade.

Reassessment

Opportunities for reassessment will be determined on a case-by-case basis, depending on the nature of the assignment.

Make-up Work

Students should consult Google Classroom or Schoology to keep up with assignments missed due to absence. Students who are absent on the day an assignment is due should submit the assignment via email, Schoology, or Google Classroom.
