Homework

Homework will be assigned from time to time. **Homework not turned in on time will be given an interim grade of “0”. This will be replaced with a numerical grade immediately upon submitting work.** Homework assignments, if any, will be posted daily on Google Classroom.

Late Work

Whether it is a homework assignment, a missed assessment (quiz or test), or a project, assignments not turned in on time will be marked “Missing/Required” and will get an **interim** grade of 0. With the exception of missed work due to excused absences, late homework assignments and projects will be docked 25% for every class meeting that it is not turned in. Due dates will be posted on Google Classroom.

Explanation of Zeroes

Homework not turned in on time will be given an interim grade of “0”. This will be replaced with a numerical grade immediately upon submitting work.

Whether it is a homework assignment, a missed assessment (quiz or test), or a project, assignments not turned in on time will be marked “Missing/Required” and will get an **interim** grade of 0.

Zeros are interim and will be replaced upon submission of work.

Reassessment

Test Retakes: Students are encouraged to retake portions of a unit test based on skills missed. In order to avail, students must have no missing assignments or unverified absences. In addition, students must provide written proof of efforts to re-learn those skills. A set of reasonable guidelines to retake assessments will be provided. Schedules for retake will be upon the discretion of the teacher. Scores will be banked until desired grade is reached.

Make-up Work

If you miss an assignment because of an absence, it is your responsibility to find out your missing assignments. All work will be posted on our Google Classroom page and in the folder at the front of the room. All make-up work should be turned in no later than 1 week after the due date.
