



Grading Practices

School: Kempsville High School

Subject(s): Latin I-IV

Grade Level: 9-12

Homework

No formal Homework is assigned. Students are given the option to complete work outside of class time if needed, at home or during study block.

Late Work

Late work is handled on a case by case basis depending on the reason for and amount of late work. Late work is accepted with no more than a 5% penalty until two weeks before grades are due at the end of the grading period.

Explanation of Zeroes

A zero will be entered as a grade if and when the student fails to submit or present an assignment. A zero is not permanent until grades are entered for the quarter. A zero is used as communication to the student and parents that work is overdue or missing. See Late Work section.

Reassessment

Reassessments are offered on a case by case basis. Students must make an appointment with the teacher to review and re-take the assessment under the supervision of the teacher. The student will earn half credit back for incorrect responses. The original assessment must have complete answers to be corrected/reassessed.

Make-up Work

Make-up work is handled on a case by case basis depending on the reason for and length of the absence. Students must request the work and make an appointment to make up assessments. Make-up work is accepted with no penalty until two weeks before grades are due at the end of the grading period.

Extra Credit

Formal extra credit is not offered. Students may, however, complete extra options on assessments for more credit. For example, if students are to choose five of eight sentences to write in the target language and they correctly complete seven, they will be given extra points for completing work beyond the requirements of the assessment.
