Homework

Homework shall not exceed 10% of a student's cumulative grade. Failure to complete homework will result in an incomplete assignment.

Late Work

Students are expected to complete all assignments on time. In the event that a student does not, points will be deducted for failing to complete/submit an assignment on the provided due date. The deadline to submit late work will be 1 week following the due date.

Explanation of Zeroes

Students are expected to be held accountable for completing missed assignments. The deadline to submit late work will be 1 week following the due date. Students who do NOT turn in their assignment before the deadline will be assigned a zero. Only students with extenuating circumstances will have the opportunity to have the zero grade reevaluated.

Reassessment

Reassessment will be available for students who earn a 63% or lower on a summative assessment within a two week time frame. Alternative performance based assessments may be given at the teacher's discretion. Student must initiate the scheduling of the makeup assessment.

Make-up Work

It is the student's responsibility to make up all missed assignments after an absence. It is recommended that students check Schoology for missed assignments posted. The student must make arrangements with the teacher to complete makeup work upon returning to school. Makeup tests and quizzes may be scheduled after school or with prior arrangement during the school day.

Extra Credit

Students may take advantage of extra credit opportunities when available. Extra credit will not be used for non-learning activities.
