Subject(s): Spanish

Grade Level: I, II

Homework

Students are expected to study the vocabulary for each lesson and all material from the previous. On some occasions the students will be required to complete a task at home that they were given class time to do but were not able to finish.. Students are expected to charge their Chromebooks every night and come to class prepared with all materials.

Late Work

For excused class absences, late assignments will be accepted for credit and without penalty on the next time period after the student's return. When attended class but failed to turn in an assignment, a grade of zero will be entered in the gradebook until the makeup work is turned in. The penalties for late work are as follows: 1 class period late will receive 10 points deduction from the final grade, 2 class periods late will receive 20 points deduction, 3 class periods late will receive 30 points deduction. After 3 classes late, the work will receive only a maximum of a 50%. Grades.

Explanation of Zeroes

A zero will be entered as a grade if and when the student fails to submit or present an assignment. If this becomes a chronic problem, the teacher will seek additional support from parents and guidance. The teacher will assign an academic appointment to ensure that the student completes the assignment. Students who skip class on the day graded assignments are due will automatically receive a zero, and no other opportunity will be granted.

Reassessment

Reassessments on assessments will occur at the teacher's discretion and after remediation has been implemented first.

Make-up Work

Students must ask the teacher for make-up work. Make-up work should be done during Study Block and/or at home, and it is due the following class.

Extra Credit

Extra credit opportunities will be given on a case by case basis and only after all previous assignments are completed.

The needed information is posted in schoology and it is also posted on the board, in the classroom.
