Homework

Late Work

Reassessment

Students will correct their mistakes and the students and the teacher will discuss the correct responses. The teacher will reteach the lesson, provide different examples and activities for the students to practice and then reassess.

Students must ask the teacher for make-up work. Make-up work should be done during Study Block and/or at home, and it is due the following class.
