Homework

Late homework will not be penalized more than 50%.

The purpose of homework is to prepare for new instruction, to provide practice, and to allow for application of curricular content.

Late Work

Late work is to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%. Exemptions to this policy are at the teacher's informed professional discretion.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros on missing assignments are considered late work and are to be completed by the date of the summative assignment for each unit. Late work will not be penalized more than 50%.

Reassessment

The Social Studies department will follow the school-wide policy on reassessment.

Make-up Work

Make-up work, including tests, are to be completed within three school days after the student returns to school. Teachers will provide reasonable and flexible deadlines that take into consideration a student's individual circumstances. Students who receive unexcused absences may make up assignments at the discretion of the teacher.

Students are expected to know what they are missing while absent and be prepared to participate in regularly scheduled activities on the day of their return. Student should check Google classroom to see what was missed. If a student is absent the day before a test, they are expected to take that test upon their return.
